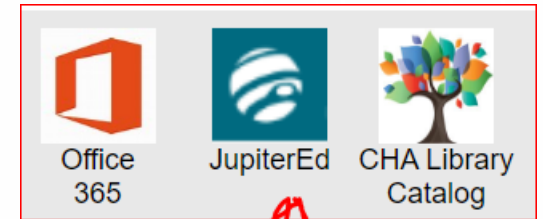


Checking your Grades on Jupiter
